It is the policy of Crossroads, Inc. that a person served and/or their legal guardian/legal representative has the right to appeal policy and/or procedure decisions made by Crossroads, Inc. management.

An appeal is a formal way of asking Crossroads to reconsider a decision that has already been made. These decisions might include declining service to an applicant, discharging someone from our services, or implementing a practice or procedure across all service environments (e.g., mandatory use of masks, remote monitoring).
